General Description.

The surface along the East of the foregoing line, is very broken and hilly with bluffs along the Missouri River, from 150 ft to 250 ft high. It is covered with a fair growth of timber some silted of Burr Oak Red Oak, Hickory, Elm, Black Walnut, and Iron wood.
