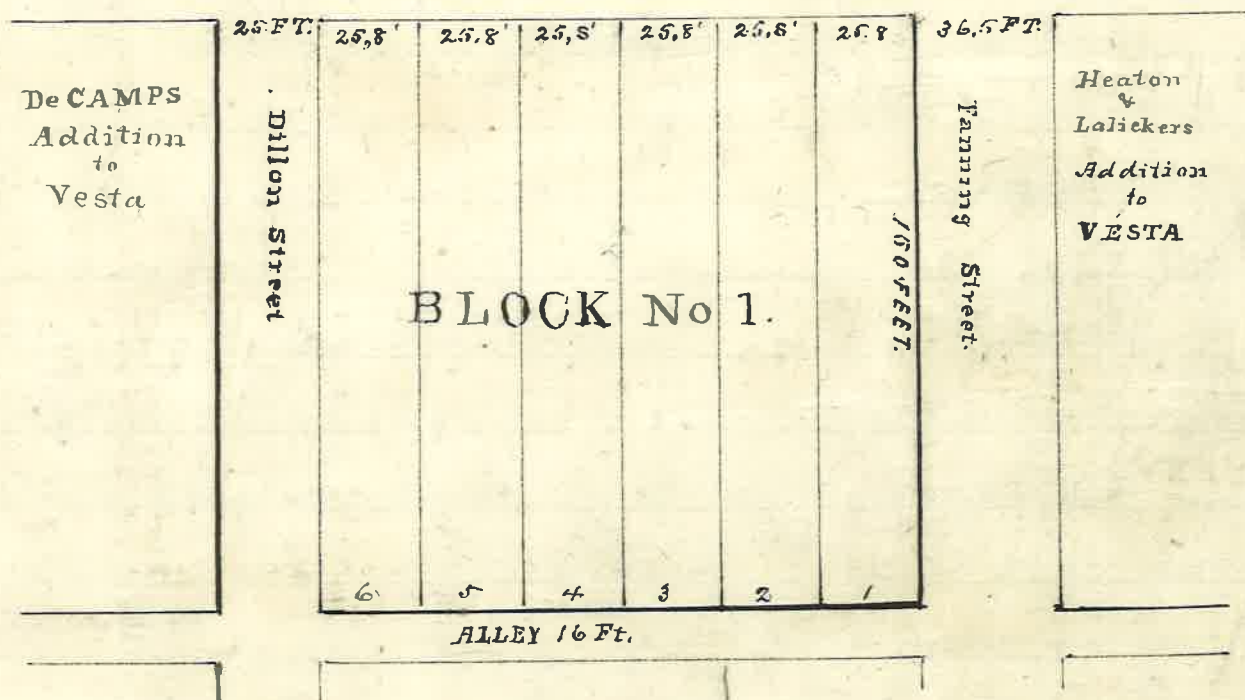

STEWART & DeCAMPS ADDITION to VESTA.

Jefferson Street.



I hereby certify that on the 19th and 20th days of March, 1889, I surveyed Stewart & DeCamp's Addition to Vesta; Said Addition is situated in the South East quarter of Section Thirty-one (31) Town Five (5) North, Range Ten (10) East in Johnson County, Nebraska, located as follows Beginning Twenty-five (25) chains and Twenty-five (25) links, ^{west} and Thirty-three (33) feet due South of the 1/4 Section corner on the East line of of one Section Thirty-one (31) and on the West side of Farming Street, and running thence West on the South line of Jefferson Street one hundred and fifty-five (155) feet - Thence due South one hundred and fifty (150) feet to an Alley - Thence due East one hundred and fifty-five (155) feet to Farming Street - Thence due North to the place of beginning, and the above is a correct Map of said Addition - The Block and lots are numbered and their dimensions are expressed by figures thereon, and the width of the Streets and Alleys are designated thereon in feet and decimals. Substantial stakes of oak wagon spokes were well driven down at all corners of Block and Lots. Witness my hand at the 22nd day of March, 1889
