

# Supplemental Plat of Sec. 36, T. 1 N., R. 18 E., 6<sup>th</sup> Prin. Mer., Nebraska.



### MEMORANDUM.

This plat delineates a retracement and reestablishment of the lines defining the lands in Section 36, Township 1 North, Range 18 East, 6th Principal Meridian, Nebraska, as shown upon the plat of the original survey approved June 19, 1891, in their true original position according to the best available evidence of the position of the original corners, and an extension survey including lands formed by accretion. The heavy irregular line delineates the position of the meander line of the right bank of Missouri River as surveyed in 1890. All differences between the measurements shown on the original plat and those derived in the retracement have been distributed proportionally between accepted corners in accordance with surveying rules.

Titles and areas based upon the original plat remain undisturbed for position and description. The area of Lot 3 of Section 36 is shown in two parts: part "a" denoting the original area as shown upon the plat of the survey approved June 19, 1891, and part "b" denoting the accretion area of the present survey.
